

# 5 People St Project Types

## 1 Plaza

A Plaza creates publicly accessible open space by closing a portion of redundant or underused street to vehicular traffic.



## 2 Parklet

A Parklet converts one or more on-street parking spaces into people-oriented places.



### Plaza & Parklet: Site Criteria

- Posted speed limit 25 MPH or less
- Does not block driveway access
- Does not restrict access to emergency vehicles, fire hydrants, or public utilities
- Does not include bus stop
- Does not interfere with public transit
- Provides alternative access to delivery trucks and sanitation vehicles

### Plaza or Parklet: Application Requirements

- Letters of support
  - Letter from local Council Office
  - Letters from nearby entities associated with color curb zones if the proposal involves relocation of those zones
  - Letters from adjacent property owners and/or other directly impacted
- Proof of Neighborhood Council Presentation
- Existing Conditions Site Plan
- Existing Conditions Photos
- Model and Color-Scheme Worksheet
- Budget and Maintenance Plan
- *PLAZA ONLY*: Programming Prospectus
- *PLAZA ONLY*: Financial Statements

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## 3 Decorative Crosswalk \*

A Decorative Crosswalk activates public space and helps grab attention of drivers while enlivening the pedestrian experience.



## 4 Intersection Mural \*

An Intersection Mural focuses driver attention on the road while celebrating community history and culture through public art.



### Mural or Crosswalk: Application Requirements

- Council Office letter of acknowledgement
- Proof of Neighborhood Council Presentation
- Existing Conditions Site Plan
- Existing Conditions Photos
- Concept Drawing

### Crosswalk: Site Criteria

- Existing continental (zebra-striped) crosswalks at local, collector or arterial streets
- Existing continental crosswalks controlled by a traffic signal or stop sign
- No yellow school crosswalks or uncontrolled crosswalks

### Mural: Site Criteria

- Local or collector streets
- Intersections controlled by a traffic signal or stop sign

## 5 Bicycle Corral\*

A Bicycle Corral is an on-street bicycle parking facility that replaces 1 or more parking spaces.



### Bike Corral: Application Requirements

- Letters of support
  - Letters from nearby entities associated with color curb zones if the proposal involves relocation of those zones
  - Letters from adjacent property owners and/or other directly impacted
- Existing Conditions Site Plan
- Existing Conditions Photos
- Maintenance Agreement

### Bike Corral: Site Criteria

- Posted speed limit 35 MPH or less
- Does not block driveway access
- Does not interfere with catch basin, storm drain, manhole or utility access
- Is unobstructed by sidewalk furniture, benches, newstands, bus shelter, trees, or other landscaping
- Is not located on a State Highway
- Is not located in or directly adjacent to a bus zone
